

Scholarship Information

1. **Lincoln Lane Foundation** - Requirements include a 3.0 GPA and financial need. Send a hand written note to The Lincoln Lane Foundation, 207 Granby Street, Suite 302, Norfolk Virginia 23510. Be sure to include your return address and name in your letter.
2. **Coca-Cola Scholars Program** - You must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. The deadline is October 31st. Apply online - see your guidance counselor for the information.
3. **Hampton Roads African American AASAF Sports Hall of Fame** - Deadline September 19th.
4. **VMI** - You must have a 3.6 or higher GPA and 1200 or higher on the SAT or 28+ on the ACT. The deadline for fall applications is November 15th.
5. **The Gloria Wille Bell and Carlos R. Bell Scholarship Program** - Scholarships available for students admitted to The University of Michigan.
6. **Air Force ROTC Scholarships** - Must have a 3.0 or better GPA and a 24 or better on the ACT.
7. **USDA/1890 National Scholars Program** - Must attend one of the 17 1890 Historically Black Land-Grant Institutions (Virginia State and North Carolina A&T are 2 of those schools), must have a 3.0 or better GPA and must either have a 1000+ on the SAT or 21+ on the ACT.
8. **The Randolph-Macon College Presidential Scholars Program** - Must have high academic achievement (SAT of 1100 or above and be in the top 25% of the class) and leadership or other talents beyond the average.
9. **Ron Brown Scholar Program** - Must be African American and have both very high academic achievement and extensive community service. Deadline to apply is Jan 9th.
10. **Mensa Education and Research Foundation Local Scholarship Program** - Must submit and essay along with the application. Deadline for submission is Jan 15th.
11. **Washington and Lee Earl Jones Scholarship** - Must apply to Washington and Lee
12. **Eleanor Davenport Leadership Scholarship for Engineering at Virginia Tech** - Must have SAT score of 1500+. See your guidance counselor if you qualify.

How to Apply

There is only one application to use in applying for all Foundation scholarships. Each year applications are available beginning December 1 for the following academic year. Students must complete and return them by March 1 (unless otherwise indicated) in order to be considered for scholarships. All applicants will be notified in May as to whether they received a scholarship.

Chesapeake, Norfolk, Portsmouth or Virginia Beach public school students should request an application directly from their guidance counselor after December 1. Counselors have been asked to pre-screen applications and recommend finalists to the Foundation to consider for scholarships. Please check with the school guidance office to find out specific information about your school's application process and deadlines.

All other students should request an application by completing the [on-line request form](#) or by mailing a

letter of interest after October 1.

If you would like to send a request by mail after October 1, please include the following information in your letter:

- Permanent home address
- High school attended
- College of choice
- Likely field of study

Once the Foundation receives basic information, it will determine if a student meets basic eligibility criteria to apply for any available scholarship funds. If there is a potential match, an application will be mailed after December 1.
